(d) On April 26, 2007, the Board of Directors of Monster Worldwide, Inc. (the Company) elected Robert Chrenc as a director. Mr. Chrenc will serve on the Compensation Committee which he will Chair, the Audit Committee and the Special Litigation Committee. Pursuant to the Company s 1999 Long Term Incentive Plan, Mr. Chrenc received 5,000 shares of the Company s Common Stock, 50% of which vested on the date of grant and the remainder of which will vest on the one year anniversary of the date of grant. He will also receive \$35,000 per year for services as a director, \$25,000 per year as Chairman of the Compensation Committee and \$1,000 for each Board or Committee meeting, limited to \$3,000 per day.
