- (1) The sale reported on this Form 4 was effectuated pursuant to a Rule 10b5-1 trading plan adopted by the reporting person on 05/21/09. The price in Column 4 is a weighted average price. The prices actually received ranged from \$50.150 to \$50.300. Upon request, the reporting person will provide to the Issuer, any security holder of the Issuer, or the SEC staff information regarding the number of shares sold at each price within the range.
- (2) This option became exercisable in four equal annual installments beginning on this date.
- (3) Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of HP common stock. Dividend equivalent rights accrue with respect to these RSUs when and as dividends are paid on HP common stock. The 124.9828 dividend equivalent rights being reported reflect 124.9828 dividend equivalent rights at \$45.96 per RSU credited to the Reporting Person's account on 10/07/09.
