**BRASKEM ACQUIRES THE PROPYLENE SPLITTER ASSETS AT MARCUS HOOK  
REFINERY**

**São Paulo, Brazil, July 2nd, 2012 - Braskem** (BM&FBovespa: BRKM5, BRKM3, BRKM6; NYSE: BAK; LATIBEX: XBRK), the leading resin producer in the Americas, announces to the market that it has acquired the propylene splitter assets at Sunoco's Marcus Hook refinery and has secured feedstock supply from multiple sources that ensures its continuing operations. Braskem will process propylene through the splitter assets for use in its adjacent polypropylene plant. This acquisition represents an important step in fortifying our Marcus Hook facility for the foreseeable future and solidifying Braskem's continued commitment to the North American petrochemical market.
