## Explanation of Responses:

- (1) Restricted Stock which will vest as follows, subject to continued employment: 12,500 on 1/2/08 and 7,500 on 1/2/10.
- (2) Includes 38.197 shares acquired through the reinvestment of dividends on June 30 and September 29, 2006, at prices of \$82.95 and \$72.40 per share.
- (3) The number of underlying securities is based on the stock fund balance on September 29, 2006. The actual number of shares issuable upon the distribution date is not determinable since the stock fund is a unitized account consisting of 96% company stock and 4% money market fund. The stock account balance reflected in this report is based on a September 29, 2006, stock fund price of \$71.74 per share.
- (4) Each share of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock. Shares of phantom stock are payable in cash following the reporting person's termination of employment with the company and may be transferred by the reporting person into an alternative investment account at any time.
- (5) The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Equalization 401(k) Benefit Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's retirement or other termination of service.
- (6) Includes 4.594 phantom stock units acquired through reinvestment of dividends on June 30 and September 29, 2006, at a price of \$82.225 and \$71.74 per phantom unit.
- (7) The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Annual Incentive Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's retirement.
- (8) Includes 31.334 phantom stock units acquired through reinvestment of dividends on June 30 and September 29, 2006, at a price of \$82.225 and \$71.74 per phantom unit.
- (9) The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Long-Term Incentive Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's retirement.
- (10) Includes 49.998 phantom stock units acquired through reinvestment of dividends on June 30 and September 29, 2006, at a price of \$82.225 and \$71.74 per phantom unit.
- (11) Each share of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock. The restricted stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Restricted Stock Plan. The units represent the reinvestment of dividends and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the vesting of the reporting person's Restricted Stock.
- (12) Includes 148.194 phantom stock units acquired through reinvestment of dividends on June 30 and September 29, 2006, at a price of \$82.225 and \$71.74 per phantom unit.
- (13) Fifty percent of the options vest after two years and the remaining 50% vests after three years.

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
