In the event of a change in control, all unvested RSUs may vest immediately under certain circumstances. Upon vesting, the reporting person will receive a number of shares of HomeStreet common stock equal to the number of RSUs that vest on that date.
- (7) On January 29, 2015, the reporting person was granted 2,484 RSUs, which vest incrementally in equal amounts on January 29, 2016, January 29, 2017, and January 29, 2018, respectively.
