Robert Henrikson, Chairman of the Board, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Company, entered into such a trading plan (the "Trading Plan"). The Trading Plan provides for the sale of the Company's common stock acquired through the exercise of vested stock options. Other Company executives may adopt trading plans from time to time.
