On July 30, 2003, Wabash National Corporation ( **Wabash** ) issued a press release announcing that the initial purchasers of Wabash s 3.25% convertible senior notes due 2008 have exercised their option to purchase an additional \$25 million of these notes in a Rule 144A offering, for a total transaction size of \$125 million. Wabash intends to use substantially all of the net proceeds of this notes offering to repay a portion of its outstanding indebtedness.
